### From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners:

The media has not given it the coverage it deserves, but I'd like to make everyone aware of an important observance in the life of the Church. Our Holy Father, Pope Benedict has declared that June 2008 to June 2009 the "Year of Saint Paul" in celebration of the 2,000 anniversary of the Apostle's birth. The "Pauline Year" will take place in the special way in Rome, where for 2,000 years, under the papal altar of the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, lies the tomb that according to experts and tradition has conserved the remains of St. Paul. There, a series of liturgical, cultural, ecumenical, pastoral and social initiatives will take place, all inspired by the spirituality of the apostle. This year will also be a time of pilgrimage to the holy places associated with St. Paul and indulgences have been attached to various spiritual practices. It is the Pontiff's desire that this observance renew in the whole Church an appreciation of the teachings of St. Paul found in Holy Scripture. Pope Benedict prays that this celebration may help the Church "...advance in the humble and sincere search for the full unity of all the members of the mystical body of Christ."

On the parish level, I have made available at the doors of the church commemorative prayers cards that may assist our personal prayer. I have also added to the parish library three copies of the international bestseller: *Paul, Least of the Apostles—The Story of the Most Unlikely Witness to Christ* by Alain Decaux (Pauline Books and Media, 2006) and a book for children: *Saint Paul-The Thirteenth Apostle* by Mary Lee Hill (Pauline Books and Media, 2007) This book will also be included in the school library. I invite you to take advantage of these works—summertime reading, perhaps!?

May St. Paul, the Vessel of election, the Apostle, the Preacher of truth in the whole world, pray for us!

***Are You Recently Engaged?***

Congratulations! If you plan to have your wedding at Our Lady of Sorrows – St. Anthony parish you need to contact Joan Bartolomei at the parish office a year prior to your planned date. You can schedule your wedding for either a Friday evening, late Saturday morning, or Saturday afternoon. A date cannot be scheduled until you (both the bride and groom) meet with Joan. At that meeting, she will discuss the diocesan and parish guidelines with you. Once you meet with her, and depending on whether you want a Mass or a Ceremony, a priest or deacon will be assigned to officiate at your wedding and to prepare you for the sacrament of marriage. Preparation involves meeting with the priest or deacon, a marriage preparation class such as Pre Cana, and the FOCCUS, which is an instrument designed to help couples learn more about themselves and their relationship. ***Choosing a Sponsor for Baptism and Confirmation?  
Before asking, consider....***

*A sponsor is to help the baptized lead a Christian life in harmony with baptism and fulfill faithfully the obligations connected to it.*

*According to Church Law, a sponsor must be:*

- ü *Designated by the candidate or in the case of infant baptism, by the candidate's parents*
- ü *At least 16 years of age (the pastor may make an exception for a just cause)*
- ü *Catholic—receiving the Sacraments of Initiation (Eucharist & Confirmation)*
- ü *Lead a life in harmony with the faith and the role to be undertaken*
- ü *Living in a valid union (a marriage “recognized” or “blessed” by the Catholic Church)*

*Other important points:*

- ü *A candidate's parent may not serve as a sponsor*
- ü *Only one sponsor (male or female) is required but two sponsors, one of each sex is permitted for baptism. One may not designate two godparents of the same sex*
- ü *A baptized non-Catholic cannot be a Catholic sponsor but may assist as a Christian “witness”*
- ü *A person's baptismal sponsor may also take this role at Confirmation provided he/she meets the criteria above.*
