**From the Pastor's Desk**

Dear Parishioners,

Last Wednesday, I received a phone call from Bishop Smith informing me of the transfer of our parochial vicar, **Father. J.C. Garrett**, effective August 29. His Excellency had already spoken to Father Garrett in person earlier that day and expressed his intention to appoint him parochial vicar of Saint Theresa's Parish in Tuckerton.

In his conversation with me, Bishop Smith also informed him that he had appointed **Father Eugene K. Savarimuthu** as our new parochial vicar. He will arrive on August 29.

I am certain that this change has bitter-sweet fruits for Father Garrett. There is the difficulty in moving from what is familiar—his hometown; a parish where he has ministered and established relationships. There is also the joy (and just a little trepidation) at beginning in a new town (the Jersey shore!) and meeting and ministering to a new community. The priesthood is indeed an adventure and priests understand that these changes are a part of the vocation.

I take this opportunity to express to Father Garrett in the name of all, our heartfelt appreciation for his priestly ministry and the assurance of our good wishes and prayers as he opens this new chapter in his priestly life.

I have asked Father Garrett to celebrate the **11:00 a.m. Mass on Sunday, August 24**, after which refreshments will be served in Our Lady of Sorrows Church Hall. There we will have an opportunity to offer him our good wishes. We might pray the following in these days for both Father Garrett and Father Savarimuthu ("Fr. Gene").
