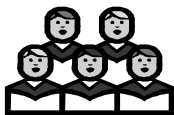

Why Have Eucharistic Adoration?

What is the relationship of Eucharistic adoration to the Mass?

The celebration of the Eucharist in the sacrifice of the Mass is "truly the origin and purpose of the worship that is shown to the Eucharist outside of Mass." Eucharistic adoration extends Holy Communion in a lasting way and prepares us to participate more fully in the celebration of the Eucharistic mystery. It leads us to acknowledge Christ's marvelous Presence in the sacrament and invites us to the spiritual union with Him that culminates in sacramental communion.

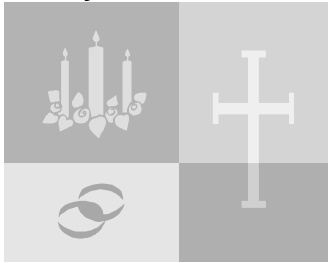
