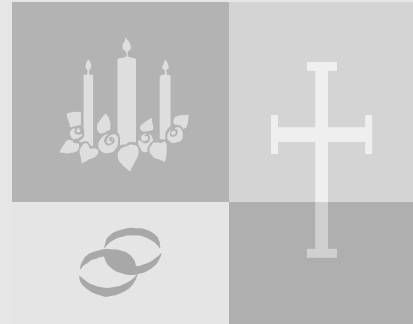

Eucharistic Adoration

*Practice established by Msgr. Edward O’Keefe in 1985.
Adoration takes place in the Chapel of Mary’s Haven.*

Is the Holy Eucharist exposed for the purpose of private devotion?

No. The liturgical rites for Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament are found in the ritual book *Holy Communion and Worship of the Eucharist Outside of Mass* and presume the presence of a number of people during the period of adoration. The rites require that during the period of exposition “there should be prayers, songs, and readings to direct the attention of the faithful to the worship of Christ the Lord.” The Liturgy of the Hours may also be celebrated during the period of exposition, or the Rosary may be prayed.

During Cherub classes the children are introduced to Scripture stories, songs, prayers, and practices, as well as fun-filled, faith-filled crafts and activities.

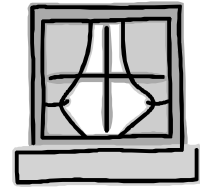
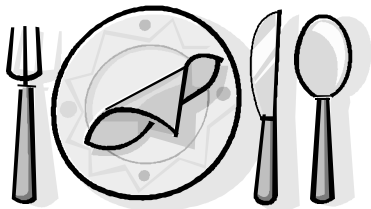
Where do I sign my child up?
